

## MUSIC

MUSIC is an important part of the ministry at St. Stephen's. Choir, soloists, instrumentalists and a seasonal concert series provide inspiration for worship and special events. Chancel Choir presents an Offertory Anthem at the 10:30 a.m. service except for months having a fifth Sunday, when guest soloists provide special music. Special music is also offered on the second Sunday of the month at the 8:00 am service. Organ, piano and instruments lead the congregation in song. Chancel Choir meets on Wednesday evenings at 5:30 in the Choir Room. During summer months, our choir has a well deserved break and music is provided by soloists.



“Music for the Seasons at St. Stephens” is a series of concerts for fall, winter, spring and summer. The opening fall concert is an organ recital, followed by a winter instrumental concert. The spring concert is presented by the St. Stephen's Players and includes choir, soloists, instrumentals, drama and always a surprise! This is coordinated using talented people from our congregation and friends. The summer concert is held informally in the Parish Hall with a light musical program. These events are open to the public and supported by donations.
